Association of Texas Appraisers (ATA) AWARDS

Outstanding Service Awards

ATA will present annual Real Property Appraiser Outstanding Service Awards for those regions of Texas in which there is membership representation. The current areas to be considered for Outstanding Service Awards are as follows (regional areas are subject to change by vote of the ATA Board of Directors):

North Texas Rio Grande Valley Central Texas East Texas

Outstanding Service Awards are to be considered for each of the following categories:

- ATA Outstanding Service Award
- Outstanding Service Award Non-Member Appraiser
- Outstanding Service Award Appraisal Service Provider (Non-Appraiser)

The Outstanding Service Awards will be presented at each ATA Meeting held in the respective area/region. The ATA will solicit nominations for these awards at each respective meeting, in the "Connections" newsletter and emails sent from the President. If there are no nominations (or insufficient nominations), the ATA Board of Directors may submit nominations or may choose to forego the Non-Member Appraiser and Appraisal Service Provider awards for that time period.

ATA Appraiser of the Year Award

ATA will make one "Appraiser of the Year Award" annually for all ATA membership. During the Annual Meeting each August, area Outstanding Service Award winners will be introduced to the general membership. The Appraiser of the Year will be selected by the ATA Board of Directors and may or may not be selected from the regional Outstanding Service Award recipients.

Selection Procedures for ATA Awards

Winners of the Outstanding Service Award will be selected from submitted nominations by vote of the ATA Board of Directors and previous years' ATA Appraiser of the Year Award recipients (an appraiser will not be eligible to win this award in consecutive years). There are no restrictions as to who may submit nominations. The Board of Directors will select the Appraiser of the Year from all nominations submitted over the previous year. Deadline for nominations is June 30 in order to follow the ATA fiscal calendar year. Nominations will be accepted all year for all regions. Nominations received after June 30 will be considered for the following fiscal year. If there are no nominations for a Non-Member Appraiser or Appraisal Service Provider in a particular region, the Board of Directors may vote at their discretion to not make award presentations for that time period.

Criteria for ATA Awards

In evaluating the nominations for awards, the ATA Board of Directors will consider the impact the nominee has had on the appraisal profession, community involvement, outside activities and their contributions to the ATA:

- ATA Outstanding Service Award Nominee must have a certified general or residential license issued by the Texas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board (TALCB) and an ATA member in good standing
- Outstanding Service Award Non-Member Appraiser Nominee must be an active licensed or certified real estate appraiser by the Texas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board (TALCB).
- Outstanding Service Award Appraisal Service Provider (Non-Appraiser) Nominee must have made a significant contribution to the real property appraisal profession.
